

ORDINANCE NO. 07.27.20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOLLAND, TEXAS, AMENDING WATER RATES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Central Texas Water Supply Corporation has raised its water rates charged to the City by \$0.12 per gallons; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Holland to increase the rate of water charged to City water customers to match the water rate increase from Central Texas Water Supply Corporation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLAND, TEXAS:

Part 1. Enacted

THAT the monthly water service usage rates of the City of Holland shall be as follows:

0 to 2000 gallons	\$34.82
2000 to 4000 gallons	\$ 6.54 per thousand
5000 and above gallons	\$ 7.54 per thousand

Part 2. Repealing Clause

All provisions in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


Part 3. Severability Clause

That if any provision, word, sentence, paragraph, clause, phrase or section of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is adjudged or held invalid, void or unconstitutional, the invalid, void or unconstitutional portion shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect.

Part 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect on August 1, 2020.
